Historic Formula I enthusiasts Urs Eberhardt, Freddy Kumschick and Hans Peter formed a Swiss enclave in the Oulton Park paddock on Saturday. Kumschick is currently completing the restoration of an ex-Jochen Rindt/ Wilson Fittipaldi Lotus 69 F2 chassis, incidentally. He also intends to race this in England next year.
